Fiscal Analysis

HB 1400 creates a program but makes its actions, "subject to availability of funding as appropriated by the Oklahoma Legislature", therefore, the measure is budget neutral to the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), because, either the Legislature will provide funding covering the costs of the actions required by HB 1400, or in the event the Legislature does not provide funding, no actions by ODOT are required.
