**Research Analysis**

HB 1400, as introduced, directs the Oklahoma Department of Transportation to select one pilot program created by the United States Department of Transportation or the National Aeronautic and Space Administration, for the purpose of studying a new mode or type of transportation, to receive a direct one-to-one match for investments from the local or tribal government identified by the pilot program.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1400 creates a program but makes its actions, “subject to availability of funding as appropriated by the Oklahoma Legislature”, therefore, the measure is budget neutral to the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), because, either the Legislature will provide funding covering the costs of the actions required by HB 1400, or in the event the Legislature does not provide funding, no actions by ODOT are required.
