**Research Analysis**

The second floor amendment to HB1416:

- Makes diversionary court programs only available to defendants of felony crimes
- Removes one of the proposed funding sources of the Oklahoma Diversionary Court Funding Program Revolving Fund. Removes the \$1/inmate per diem rate placed on private prison contractors. Instead, the fund will consist exclusively of funds appropriated by the Legislature using a formula of \$1/inmate per day the inmate is in a private prison during the previous fiscal year.
