Research Analysis

HB 1912, as introduced, increases the travel allowance amount that may be received by county officers in lieu of reimbursement. Allowances for each county commissioner and sheriff are increased from \$600 to \$700, for each county assessor from \$500 to \$600, and for each county clerk, court clerk and county treasurer from \$400 to \$500.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure includes increases in the amount county officers may receive in lieu of reimbursement for traveling expenses within their counties. Present and proposed language is permissive as to the payment of the allowance.

Were all seventy-seven (77) counties to offer all officers an allowance and authorize the increase as proposed, the statewide cost might approach \$739,200 annually, or \$9,600 per county.
