**Research Analysis**

HB 1921, as introduced, creates a statewide virtual presence initiative. The measure directs the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, State Board of Career and Technology Education, Department of Commerce, and the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) to create a research and development proposal to make Oklahoma a leader in virtual presence. OMES is further directed to work with agencies, boards and commissions to develop virtual presence capabilities for state employees.
