**Research Analysis**

HB 1927 lowers the term of imprisonment for a person who commits assault and battery upon medical care providers from 2 years imprisonment to 1 year imprisonment. The measure increases the term of imprisonment for a person who commits aggravated assault and battery upon medical care providers from not more than 1 year imprisonment to not more than 2 years imprisonment. The measure amends the definition of “medical care provider” to include laboratory technicians and radiologic technologists.
