Research Analysis

HB 1931 provides that a misdemeanor warrant is to not be effective for an amount of time greater than the statute of limitations for the underlying crime. The measure requires that every misdemeanor warrant include the date of expiration, provided that the date of expiration is to be no longer than 3 years after the date of issuance, after which point the warrant is no longer valid. The measure provides that this requirement is to be applied retroactively.
