**Research Analysis**

HB 2017, as introduced, requires all new, renovated, or replacement state and municipal buildings which open after January 1, 2020, to include at least one baby changing table. This requirement applies only to those renovations or replacements if the value of the renovation or replacement exceeds 50% of the value of the building.

**Fiscal Analysis**

Officials from the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) estimate the impact of HB 2017 in its current form to be \$2,200 per year for the State. OMES bases their estimate on the following assumptions:

- on average one new construction per year,
- on average ten major renovations per year,
- estimated cost and install of \$200 per changing table, (11 tables/yr. \* \$200 = \$2,200/yr.)
- adequate space will exist within building designs requiring no additional square footage construction.
