Fiscal Analysis

The measure in its current form is expected to bring an additional 760 recipients to the OHLAP scholarship program in its inaugural year of FY2023 with an added cost of \$3.8 million. It is anticipated that the number of recipients will grow over time to an estimated 2,700 by year five with an additional cost of approximately \$16.2 million.
