Research Analysis

The CS for HB 2041 creates the Radiologic Technologist Licensure Act. The measure requires any individual who is not a licensed physician, chiropractor, podiatrist or dentist with specialized training in the use of radiation, and who performs fluoroscopy, nuclear medicine technology, radiation therapy, radiography or related procedures, to be licensed by the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision. Further, the bill requires that a licensed allopathic or osteopathic physician supervise the services of a limited X-ray machine operator, nuclear medicine technologist, radiation therapist or radiographer.
