**Research Analysis**

The CS for HB 2053 modifies the list of individuals who can view or receive a copy of a birth or death certificate. Provides that a parent named on the birth record who is incarcerated is not entitled and the funeral home of record on the death certificate can obtain copies for no more than 3 years after the date of death.
