**Research Analysis**

The Committee Substitute for HB 2071 prohibits any person, employer or business entity from creating or enforcing any policy or rule that has the effect of prohibiting any person or employee of the business entity, except a convicted felon, from transporting, carrying or storing firearms or ammunition in a motor vehicle personally owned, leased or rented by the person or employee while conducting business for the business entity.
