**Research Analysis**

HB 2092 allows municipal officials who are in possession of a valid handgun license issued pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act and who have been granted the authority pursuant to an ordinance adopted by the municipality may carry a concealed handgun when acting in the performance of their duties within the municipal buildings of the municipality in which he or she is employed.
