Research Analysis

HB 2098 creates the 21st Century Motor Tag Agent Act. The measure prohibits a member or employee of the Tax Commission or any person related to a member or employee of the Tax Commission from appointment as a tag agent. The measure removes the prohibition on legislators or family members of legislators from being a tag agent. The measure increases the fine for a motor license agent or employee of an agent to operate a messenger or delivery service from \$1,000 to \$2,000. The measure increases the fee that a motor license agent may charge for mailing a document from 50 cents to \$1. The measure increases the fee that a motor license agent may charge for mailing a license plate from \$1 to \$2. The measure increases the fee that a motor license agent may charge for mailing a decal from 50 cents to \$1 and the cost of mailing any other form from 50 cents to \$1.
