HB 2142 creates the Tri-State Commission on the McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System, in anticipation of being joined in the commission by Arkansas and Kansas. The commission would consist of three House members and three Senate members whose legislative districts encompass part of the territory in which the river navigation system is located, as well as one member of the Water Advisory Board of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation, to be selected by the Governor.
