Research Analysis

Engrossed HB 2143 creates a revolving fund for the purpose of repairing or constructing essential assets which are part of the McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System (MKARNS).

Senate Amendments to HB 2143 specify that monies in the revolving fund must be used for MKARNS, and may only be expended after consultation with all Native American tribes with an ownership interest in the riverbed.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2143 in its current form creates the McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System (MKARNS) and vests the fund with the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT). The measure does not direct any funding be provided to the Fund; therefore, HB 2143 in its current form has no direct fiscal impact on the state budget or revenues.
