**Research Analysis**

HB 2150, as introduced, specifies that certain actions by a municipality constitute a *taking* under Article 2 of the Oklahoma Constitution. These actions include substantially interfering with use and enjoyment of mineral estate, imposing a limitation that adversely impacts use of minerals, or prohibiting access to develop the mineral estate.
