**Research Analysis**

The SA's to HB 2286 makes numerous technical clarifications to OSBI procedures regarding the issuance of handgun licenses. The measure requires OSBI to conduct a check of the National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS) prior to the issuance of a handgun license to a peace officer if no prior check is on file. The measure allows OSBI to notify license holders by email 90 days prior to expiration of a license. The measure requires any person with a valid firearm license from another state must apply for a handgun license within 90 days of establishing residence in this state if the person carries a firearm pursuant to a firearm license.
