HB 2312 expands the concurrent enrollment tuition waiver eligibility to all high school students. The measure allows courses offered at the undergraduate level through the University of Oklahoma-Tulsa Schusterman Center, Northeastern State University, and Langston University to duplicate those offered by Tulsa Community College.

Fiscal Analysis

In its current form, the measure would allow all high school students who meet the eligibility requirements to enroll in a concurrent course. The estimated cost to expand the eligibility pool would be approximately \$17,859,456. When the current appropriation of \$10,216,349 is taken into consideration, the estimated funding needed to fulfill the requirements set forth in the measure is \$7,643,107.
