Research Analysis

The CS for HB 2338 changes the date for county reapportionment following the Federal Decennial Census from on or before October 1 to on or before June 1. Modifies the starting date of the candidate filing period from the second Wednesday of April in even-numbered years to the first Monday in December. The measure also provides for a supplemental candidate filing period in April for members of a newly formed recognized political party.

Fiscal Analysis

Officials from the State Election Board have reviewed HB 2338 in its current form and communicate that there are scenarios that could occur resulting in the need for staff overtime, as a result of HB 2338; however, such scenarios are only speculative and cannot be quantified at this time. Under current analysis, HB 2338 in its current form has no direct fiscal impact on the state budget or state revenues.
