HB 2364 adds to the list of offenses that do not require proof that the person engaging in the conduct had knowledge that the victim of the underlying offense was pregnant or that the offender intended to cause the death or bodily injury to the unborn child. The offenses added are: Murder in the First Degree, Murder in the Second Degree, First Degree Manslaughter and Second Degree Manslaughter.
