Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB2423 creates the Oklahoma Benefit Corporation Act to establish a framework to allow new and existing corporations to elect to become a benefit corporation when filing or amending its certificate of incorporation. Benefit corporations are required to meet different standards of corporate purpose, accountability and transparency and must:

- Have a purpose of creating public benefits and may amend its certificate of incorporation to add, amend and delete specific goals;
- Consider the impact of their decisions on many stakeholders, including workers, the community and the environment; and
- Prepare an annual benefit statement to shareholders as to the corporation's promotion of its general and specific public benefit.
