**Research Analysis**

HB 2468 creates the Oklahoma Gestational Agreement Act and establishes a process by which a woman, who is at least 21 years of age, agrees to become pregnant with the genetic child of one or more intended parents and/or one or more donors by means of assisted reproduction. The measure requires that a district court validate the gestational agreement and provides that the gestational carrier may receive reimbursement for expenses and be paid a reasonable compensation for carrying the child.
