**Research Analysis**

Engrossed HB 2472 prohibits a railcar from blocking vehicle traffic at a crossing on a public highway or street for longer than 10 minutes, with exceptions for emergency conditions or if the train is continuously moving. Further, one-time exceptions for an additional 10 minutes are added when a train is unable to complete a switching maneuver while setting out or picking up rail cars or for stopping to allow passage of a second train which has exhausted its 10 minutes.
