**Research Analysis**

The SA's to HB 2516 allows the owner or lessee of a noncommercial vehicle to inform the Tax Commission that the owner, lessee or someone who may be operating the vehicle is deaf, hard-of-hearing, autistic or suffers from Apraxia or a communication disorder. That information, if provided, shall be available to law enforcement through the Tax Commission's vehicle registration system to assist law enforcement in identifying the operator of the vehicle as possibly being deaf, hard-of-hearing, autistic or suffers from Apraxia or a communication disorder.
