**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 2547 allows municipalities, by ordinance, to authorize all or certain municipal employees to carry concealed firearms. The employee must have been issued a valid handgun license pursuant to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act. The measure provides that the municipality is not liable for any loss, damage or injuries that occur in relation to or caused by the possession or storage of a firearm by an employee. The measure provides immunity to civil and criminal liability to the employee. The measure prohibits carrying of firearm in prohibited locations and defines such locations.

The measure repeals Title 11, Section 22-139 relating to designation of personnel to attend armed security guard or reserve peace officer training.
