Research Analysis

Amendment 1 to the proposed committee substitute for HB2593 updates and clarifies the function and activities that are performed by a qualified organization.

With the amendment, the measure provides a sales tax exemption for sales to or by an 501(c)(3) organization created pursuant to Oklahoma law, which functions primarily as a private family and child welfare agency for undertaking activities that:

- Foster and strengthen family life;
- Develop the capacities of individual adults, families and children towards a satisfying and socially useful life; and
- Provide social casework, foster care and other services to assist in the physical, social, economic, emotional and intellectual adjustment of individuals either child or adult.
