The committee substitute to HB 2613 provides a definition for the term “physician” within the medical marijuana statutes to mean a doctor of medicine, a doctor of osteopathic medicine or a doctor of podiatric medicine who holds a valid, unrestricted and existing license to practice in the State of Oklahoma and meets the definition of board certified under rules established by either the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners or the State Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners.
