**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute to HB 2614 clarifies the penalty provision contained in State Question 788 regarding possession of up to 1.5 ounces of marijuana by a person without a medical marijuana license. Clarifies that the penalty is a citation for an amount not to exceed \$400.
