## **Research Analysis**

The senate amendments to HB 2614 returns the penalty for possession of 1.5 ounces of marijuana without a license to a misdemeanor. The amendments require the physician to conduct a physical examination not utilizing telemedicine prior to issuing a recommendation. The amendments remove the definition of "physician", the requirement of physician to notify the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority of patients no longer meeting requirements, and the authorities of the Oklahoma State Department of Health in regard to its medical marijuana program. The amendments add penalties for possessing a counterfeit license and for assuming the identity of a license holder. The amendments also provide advertising and packaging requirements for medical marijuana products.
