**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB2625 deletes the requirement that traditionally certified public school superintendents, and alternatively certified public school superintendents receive a passing score on the subject area competency examination.

The measure also deletes the mandate that alternative certifications for superintendents and principals can only last three years and cannot be renewed.

Furthermore, the proposed committee substitute deletes language:

- Referring to an obsolete commission
- Requiring any person participating in an alternative certification program for superintendent of schools and principals on the effective date of this act to be subject to the program requirements in effect prior to the effective date of this act.
