The committee substitute to HB 2640 creates Francine’s Law and requires the Oklahoma Chief Medical Examiner and the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to enter data and information into the National Missing and Unidentified Persons System (Namus) when a person has been reported missing or when the Medical Examiner or OSBI have located an unidentified person.
