Research Analysis

HB 2846 creates the Oklahoma Kratom Consumer Protection Act, requiring kratom products to be appropriately labeled. Kratom products may not be mixed with a nonkratom substance. Vendors may not sell or distribute kratom products with a level of 7-hydroxymitragynine in the alkaloid fraction greater than 2% of the alkaloid composition or containing any synthetic alkaloid. Vendors may not sell kratom products to persons under the age of 18. Persons violating any of these provisions will be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 2846 creates a misdemeanor and a fine of not more than \$1,000. This could generate increased revenue for the state: however, this is contingent upon how many individuals are found guilty and the exact amount of the fine they are required to pay. The impact is most likely negligible for the state.
