Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 3010 makes numerous changes regarding firearms. The measure adds to the locations where it is lawful to carry a firearm by including any street, plaza, sidewalk, and alley if the property is designated by statute, ordinance, resolution, policy or use by a city, town, county or state governmental authority. The measure allows a person to carry openly on property of a public trust or nonprofit entity with permission of the public trust or nonprofit entity. The bill clarifies that only a citizen or permanent resident, who can lawfully purchase or possess a firearm may carry or transport a concealed or unconcealed firearm. The measure requires a person carrying a firearm to have valid identification on their person while carrying a firearm.
