Research Analysis

HB 3010 makes numerous changes regarding firearms. The measure clarifies the term “offensive weapon” in the unlawful carry statute to provide that the weapon be used for an offensive threat or attack. The measure requires that when carrying a firearm, the firearm must be carried in a general vertical position with the barrel of the firearm safely pointed in a general up or down direction. The bill clarifies that only a citizen or permanent resident, who can lawfully purchase or possess a firearm may carry or transport a concealed or unconcealed firearm. The bill removes the administrative penalty for carrying a restricted bullet by a Self-Defense Act card holder. The measure requires a person carrying a firearm to have valid identification on their person while carrying a firearm.
