**Research Analysis**

HB 3030 authorizes a person operating a bicycle may extend right hand and arm horizontally to his or her right to indicate a right turn. The measure prohibits the driver of a vehicle from using a horn when passing a bicycle or an animaldrawn vehicle under normal conditions if no imminent danger of a collision exists.
