Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 3036 allows any person who's rights have been violated by any order, policy, ordinance or regulation promulgated or enforced by any person, municipality, agency or other political subdivision of this state which restricts the sale, purchase, purchase delay, transfer, ownership, use, keeping, possession, carrying, bearing, transportation, licensing, permit, registration, taxation other than sales and compensating use taxes, or other controls on firearms, knives, firearm and ammunition components, ammunition, and supplies may bring a civil action against the person, municipality, agency or political subdivision. A court may require the political subdivision to pay reasonable expenses to a person in an action under certain conditions.
