**Research Analysis**

HB 3227 creates the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana and Patient Protection Act, which allows licensed medical marijuana dispensaries to contract with licensed medical marijuana transporters to deliver marijuana products to patients, legal guardians of patients who are minors, and caregivers. Marijuana products can only be delivered to private residences and cannot be delivered to any person or residence more than once in the same day. When delivering the products, transporters must verify the license of the recipient. Additionally, the measure reduces the annual fee for the transporter agent license is reduced from \$100 to \$25.
