## **Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3992 in its current form increases broadens the immunity of the State and political subdivisions, related to liability. The increased immunity results in decreased potential liability to the State and political subdivisions. The amount of decreased liability to the State is dependent on the number of claims avoided due to the immunity provided in this measure.
