**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3400 requires all public high schools in the state to make a minimum of four advanced placement courses available to students, beginning with the 2024-2025 school year. The State Department of Education is directed to provide information to all local boards of education, to be distributed to students and parents, on available opportunities and the advanced placement enrollment process.

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3400 also requires the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board to maintain an online learning platform that provides online classes to all Oklahoma school districts.
