**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure authorizes the movement of monies in the sum of \$187,881, from the Emergency Drought Relief Fund to the Oklahoma Conservation Commission Infrastructure Revolving Fund. The funds would be budgeted and expended by the agency for necessary conservation projects to reduce future effects of drought and by improving flood control structures in Oklahoma. The measure increases the agency's flexibility in utilizing existing funds. The measure has no direct impact on FY-21 budget resources.
