Research Analysis

HB 3906 defines *small farm producer* as a person who produces annually no less than 100 vines of sound ripe grapes, 1,000 pounds of other sound ripe fruit or berries, or 100 pounds of honey. The bill also defines *small farm winery* as a wine-making establishment that uses grapes, berries, other fruits, honey, or vegetables to produce no less than 5 percent of the wine it manufactures annually.
