Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 3908 streamlines the high school graduation requirements for a standard diploma so that all students must meet the same set of requirements.

The measure allows the successful completion of one year of a full-time career and technology program as identified by the student's ICAP to count toward a science requirement.

The committee substitute also requires students to receive, as part of the Individual Career Academic Plan (ICAP) process, information on postsecondary opportunities including admission requirements, National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) requirements, scholarship opportunities, financial aid, and other information pertinent to the successful transition into postsecondary education and/or careers.
