**Research Analysis**

HB 3908, as introduced, modifies the requirements for graduation from a public high school with a standard diploma.

The measure allows the successful completion of one year of a full-time career and technology program, as identified by the student's ICAP, to count as two units of required mathematics, or two units of required science.
