Research Analysis

SB 1005 prohibits the Department of Environmental Quality from requiring air curtain incinerators for land clearing or brush piles, except in present or past nonattainment areas for National Ambient Air Quality Standards or metropolitan statistical areas with more than 900,000 people, according to the 2010 Census.

The measure declares that burning brush piles is not a public nuisance.
