Fiscal Analysis

The CS on SB 1059 defines budget limits for the Dept. of Public Safety (DPS). From the monies appropriated in HB 2765 (the FY-20 general appropriations bill) the agency is directed to:

- Conduct 2 trooper academies;
- Utilize the proceeds from the sale of state aircraft to partially fund a trooper academy;
- Utilize \$4,000,000 of appropriated dollars to partially fund a trooper academy;
- Utilize \$1,000,000 for communication regionalization (consolidating communications buildings and staff);
- Utilize \$600,000 for the development of a REAL ID compliant point of sale system for drivers' license locations and the DPS headquarters;
- If necessary, request early transfers of tax collections to the General Revenue Fund for early allocations in case of cash flow problems;
- Utilize specific funds for specific fiscal years and to report it accordingly.
