**Research Analysis**

SB 1103 increases maximum term of punishment for domestic violence by to up to 10 years imprisonment and increases the fine from \$3,000 to \$5,000. The punishment for a second conviction for domestic violence by strangulation is increased to a possible maximum term of incarceration of up to 20 years.
