SB 141 modifies the purpose of the “Successful Adulthood Act to include giving children 14 years of age or older who are, or were, in foster care the opportunity to achieve permanent connections with a caring adult. The measure also requires the department to provide a child who is aging out of foster care official documentation showing that he or she was previously in foster care.
