**Research Analysis**

SB 1614 modifies the qualification requirements for certain positions within the Oklahoma Highway Patrol Division. The measure allows officers who possess at least 3 years' experience of law enforcement, been full-time CLEET certified law enforcement officer of a state or local law enforcement agency, been a full-time sworn law enforcement officer who has been certified by a state peace officer standards and training agency as a peace officer in another state, or any officer who has been certified as a federal peace officer by a CLEET Council recognized law enforcement agency to be appointed to the positions. The measure also provides for applicants who with prior military or law enforcement experience to receive up to 10 semester hours of credit for each year of honorable service in any active military or reserve military up to a maximum of 30 hours.
