Research Analysis

SB 162 clarifies that the physician required to sign an application for a medical marijuana license must be licensed and in good standing with the Oklahoma State Board of Medical licensure and Supervision or the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners. The measure limits the weight of a test batch to be no greater than 10 pounds. Both the grower and processor must separate each harvest/production lot into batches of no more than 10 pounds.
